This four year renewable scholarship can be rescinded under certain conditions including academic performance (minimum required GPA 3.0), enrollment status (full time student), a change of major not consistent with the related fields indicated on the application form as well as contingency of funding by Joseph Katchpole, the administrator of The Elizabeth Katchpole Memorial Scholarship Fund.

The proposed four year scholarship will be awarded as follows:
\$2500.00 High School senior year.

Upon submission of end of year transcripts from a College/University:
\$1500.00 Sophomore year
\$1500.00 Junior year
\$1500.00 Senior year

This scholarship is open to Cape Cod high school seniors planning to major in environmental fields of study, such as botany, conservation, forestry, horticulture, ecology, marine science, landscape design/architecture or a related field.
